
Forty Years Among the Old Booksellers of Philadelphia, With Bibliographical Remarks (Classic Reprint)

I do not mean a very profound knowledge, but a general one. I am aware that in the past as well as the present mere old ragmen old junk dealers have been and are metamorphosed into old booksellers a disgrace to its high intellectual worth. I am also aware of some who are mere catalogue old booksellers and who, parrot-like, can spin you off the latest books collected by a Bohn or Ouaritch, but are not aware of the contents of any of the books, nor of the special idiosyncracies of authors.(Typographical errors above are due to OCR software and dont occur in the book.)
