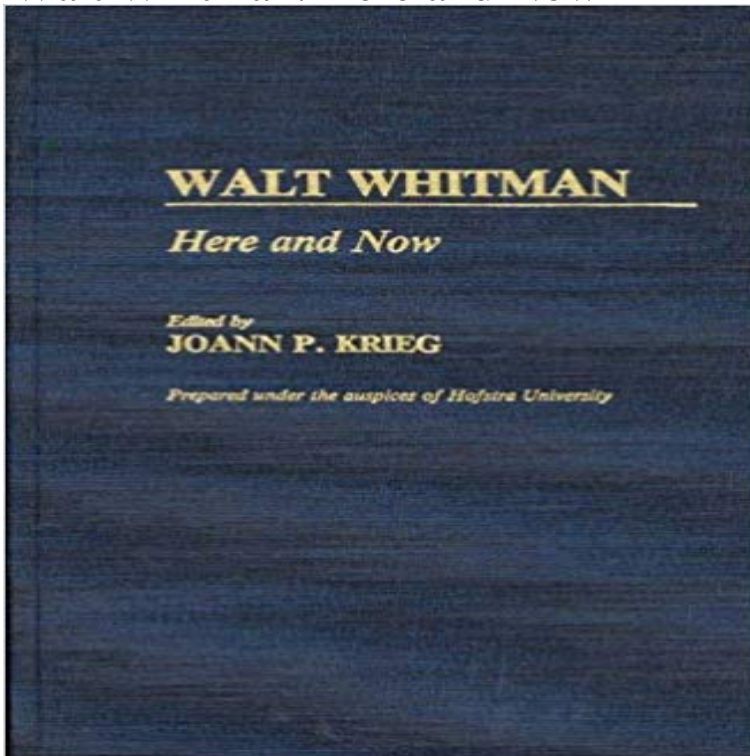


## Walt Whitman: Here and Now
