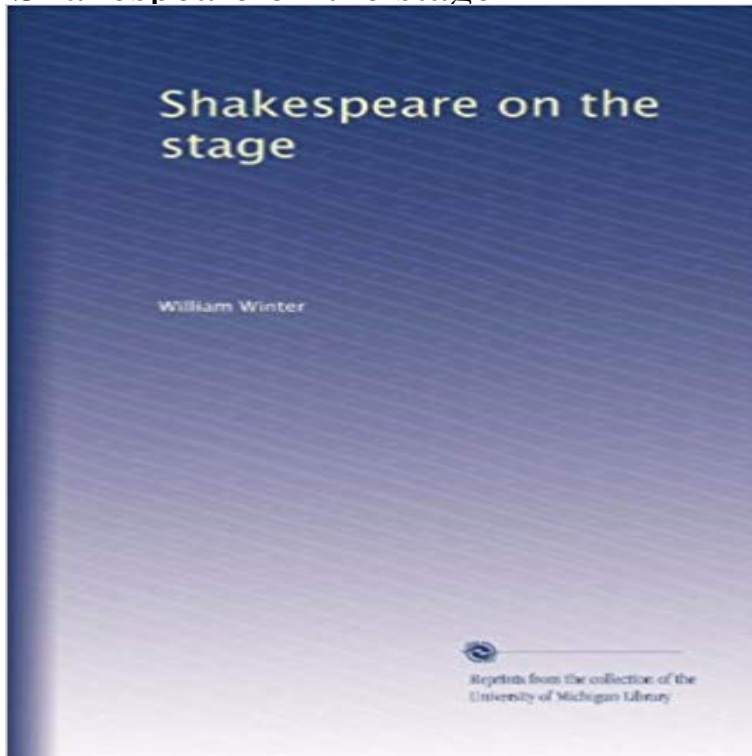


Shakespeare on the stage
